Frontier Airlines Becomes Only Carrier to Offer Non-Stop Service Between Hampton Roads and Denver

Going West Just Got Easier

NEWPORT NEWS, VA, February 4, 2010 – Frontier Airlines will begin new non-stop jet service between its Denver International Airport (DEN) hub and the Newport News/Williamsburg International Airport (PHF). Beginning May 3, 2010, Frontier Airlines will operate four weekly flights between Newport News/Williamsburg International and Denver utilizing the 99-seat E190 aircraft. On June 4, 2010, Frontier Airlines will upgrade the service utilizing the 128-seat Airbus 318. Tickets go on sale February 14, 2010 and can be purchased online at www.frontierairlines.com or by your favorite travel agency.
